This horrible disease takes the lives of over 200,000 people per year, people that have included Gord Downie, Neal Peart, Beau Biden, Ted Kennedy and the Edmonton Oilers' young fan – Ben Stelter. Blaize fought the fight with much strength and optimism undergoing chemo and radiation, but in the end he passed away 23 months later. The signatory on the Glioblastoma Cancer Research Fund is Dr. James Perry. Dr. Perry and his team are global leaders in clinical trials testing new drugs in the fight against brain cancer. The discovery of the first-ever effective targeted drug therapy (Vorasidenib) was facilitated by their leadership in a global study. They also continue to lead the glioblastoma AGILE trial in which the leading brain cancer centres of the world are collaborating to enhance the speed of drug discovery. They have also developed and lead a specialized program in brain cancers affecting adolescents and young adults under the age of 40.
